1. 55% of regularly participating students will improve to a satisfactory English Language Arts grade or above, or maintain a high grade across the program year
2. 55% of regularly participating students will improve to a satisfactory Mathematics grade or above, or maintain a high grade across the program year
3. 50% of regularly participating students will improve to a satisfactory Science grade or above, or maintain a high grade across the program year.
4. 35% of regularly participating students in third grade will achieve promotion based on their performance on the FSA
5. 80% of regularly participating students enrolled in Algebra I will pass the Algebra I End-of-Course (EOC) exam
6. 85% of regularly participating students will show increase in knowledge in Arts & Culture as measured by pre and post-test World Culture Awareness Inventories
7. 75% of regularly participating students in grades 3-5 will improve their physical fitness as measured by the President's Physical Fitness Test
8. 80% of regularly participating students in grades 6-8 will increase their knowledge in college and career readiness as measured by Interest and Engagement Inventories in College and Career
9. 50% of regularly participating family members will demonstrate increases in knowledge in Family Literacy as measured by Adult Literacy Performance Survey
